Dear Parents,

Things are hotting up... and I am not just talking about the weather! Everyday there seems to be something a little out of the ordinary happening either for a class or the whole school. The last fortnight has been an exciting one, not least for our Year 6 children who spent last week in mid-Wales, taking part in the end of year residential. I love that we put this event at the end of the year. It represents a real right of passage for the children and a celebration of the seven years they have spent with us at St Katharines. With SATs behind them, the residential is the beginning of what for this group is a very exciting end of term; they have much to look forward to. Mr Sandall and Mrs Jodrell who accompanied the children on their adventure had a wonderful time, reporting that this group of children were a joy to spend time with. What stood out for me was how well they supported each other. They took on some hard challenges throughout the week, coupled with being away from home – to know that they looked after each other so well was lovely to hear. Year 5 were lucky enough to be given the opportunity to visit the pop-up planetarium at Marlborough College on Friday 12th June. This experience, provided by the Herschel Museum in Bath, celebrated the achievements and discoveries made by William and Caroline Herschel. The children learnt about the stars and planets that they can see in the night sky and might now be able to pick out a few more constellations as a result of the visit. Our thanks to

Marlborough College for offering this experience, free of charge, to our learners.

On Wednesday last week the children in Oak, Chestnut and Sycamore were able to meet Michael Morpurgo! This was sadly not in person but via a live broadcast to primary schools across the country. The broadcast gave children an insight into what life is like as an author, the inspiration for his writing and some top tips for story writing.

On Tuesday we hosted another whole school emergency awareness training day, delivered by the incredible team at Wiltshire Air Ambulance. This day, that has become a staple in our school calendar, supports our learners, at an age-appropriate level to learn about the actions they can take to help save a life or support someone in need of help. The children were brilliant; they listened well, were enthusiastic participators and asked lots of thoughtful questions. Thank you to the PTA who fund this annual addition to our curriculum offer.

Today our Chestnut learners have spent the day time-travelling. With the help of the team at Light Up Education, the children have had an immersive day learning all about life in Saxon Britain. We are always looking for ways to bring the curriculum alive for children. Often this is through a trip to a museum or significant place. Sometimes however, it is nice for the experience to come to us. [Light Up Education](#) specialise in bringing history to life and provide the opportunity for children to hear from (another) passionate expert on a subject.

Children will need to come dressed in comfy, weather appropriate, forest school clothing, bring a packed lunch and water bottle to school with them (*there will be no Sue Brady lunches on this day*). This is the simplest of ways to spend a day and in our busy, stimulation filled lives we feel it is one of the most joyful. To watch the children walking and talking together, mixing age groups, with older children supporting younger is a privilege, one which always reminds me how lucky we are to serve such a special school community. There *might* be a treat in it for our volunteers at the end of the day! Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate younger (pre-school) siblings or dogs on our walk.

Our new starters will be joining us for a stay and play, Year 6 will have a taster day at St. John's while everyone else will spend a session with the teaching team that will be working with them in September. Some of our classes are taught by teachers that share the role; at least one member of the teaching team will be present at the session.
